The raw material for the EAF process is approximately 75% scrap steel purchased from various suppliers. This scrap consists of approximately 50% Post Consumer and 50% Post Industrial scrap. The recycled content can contain but is not limited to one or more of the following raw material types:

- #1 Bundles
- #1 Heavy Melt
- Beach Iron
- Busheling
- Cast Rolls
- Flashing
- Furnace Iron
- Internal Scrap
- P & S
- Railroad Rail and track material
- Shred
- Tin Busheling
- Turnings
